## SEED GARLIC

**2221 - 'German White' Garlic (organic)**– Big bulbs yield 4-6 huge cloves. Excellent storage. **3/\$13.25**

**2241 - 'Russian Red' Garlic (organic)**– 5-8 large plump cloves. Keeps well for over 6 months. **3/\$11.50**

## INDOOR BULBS

**2271 - 'Apple Blossom' Jumbo Amaryllis**– A classically graceful beauty, white with streaks of light pink. **1/\$10.50**

**2402 - 'Ziva' Paperwhites**– (16-18" tall)- Early paperwhite, one of the fastest to force and the most floriferous. White flowers with a strong, spicy fragrance. Takes 2 weeks to bloom. **10/\$10.50**

**2411 - Paperwhites Gift Kit**– (16-18" tall)- 3 of the above bulbs, along with growing medium, and a brushed copper oval planter. Makes a perfect holiday present. **1 Kit/\$10.75**

## CROCUS

**3652 - 'Ruby Giant'**– (VE, 3-4" tall)– Deep purplish red with a lighter base and margins. Large, vigorous, and free flowering. **20/\$4.50**

**3702 - Jumbo Crocus Mix**– (VE-ES, 4-6" tall)– A tempting mix of colors to help you welcome spring. Excellent for naturalizing and border plantings. **40/\$10.75**

## HYACINTHS

**4852 - 'Delft Blue'**– (ES, 8-12" tall)– Rich soft porcelain blue. The classic. **6/\$6.00**

**4902 - Hyacinth Mix**– (ES, 8-12" tall)– Landscape size bulbs in a beautiful mix of colors. **12/\$13.50**

## IRIS

**5091 - 'Eye of the Tiger'**– (SU, 16-24" tall)– Purple standards and deep burgundy falls with a yellow eye. One of my new found favorites. **10/\$6.50**

**5122 - Dutch Iris Mix**– (SU, 16-24" tall)– A wonderful mix of colors. Iris are regarded as one of the best cut flowers. **20/\$6.00**

## DAFFODILS (narcissus)

**6022 - 'Dutch Master'**– (ES-MS, 18-20" tall)– Large yellow petals with a scalloped yellow trumpet. Prolific with multiple flowers per bulb. **10/\$7.75**

**6072 - 'Carlton'**– (ES-MS, 18-20" tall)– Yellow petals with a deeper golden cup. Multiplies rapidly. Vanilla fragrance. One of the world's most planted narcissus. **10/\$8.25**

**6152 - 'Salome'**– (MS, 16-18" tall)– One of the most popular pinks. Long cup opens buttery, gradually turns soft pink with a yellow rim. Ivory petals. **10/\$7.75**

**6222 - Double Narcissus Mix**– (ES-LS, 12-18" tall)– A beautiful mix of double narcissus. Fragrant and very showy. **20/\$13.75**

**6282 - 'Baby Moon' Jonquil**– (LS, 6-8" tall)– Lemon yellow with round cup. Very fragrant. **10/\$4.75**

**6302 - 'Pipit' Jonquil**– (MS, 10-14" tall)- Opens lemon yellow, matures to white. Very long bloom time. **10/\$5.50**

**6362 - Butterfly Narcissus Mix**– (MS-LS, 14-18" tall)- Shades of white, yellow, orange, and gold with sunbursts of color radiating from the bicolor split cups. **10/\$9.50**

**6392 - Fragrant Narcissus Mix**– (ES-LS, 14-18" tall)- A mix of sweetly scented narcissus, great for bouquets. **20/\$10.50**

## MISCELLANEOUS BULBS (not as well known, but some of my favorites!)

**7092 - Wild About Alliums Mix**– (SU, 16-33" tall)– A mix of medium to tall alliums in violet, purple, and white. Top-size bulbs. **20/\$11.00**

**7142 - Anemone Mix**– (ES, 3-6" tall)– Also called Grecian Windflower. A small enchanting daisy. Easy to grow, they form compact clusters that make a nice ground cover under deciduous trees. **20/\$5.75**

**7162 - Glory of the Snow**– (ES, 4-8" tall)– Delicate soft blue starlike flowers with white centers. Does well in shade and full sun. Forms wonderful colonies. **20/\$5.00**

**7262 - Double Snowdrops (Galanthus nivalis)**– (VE, 4-5" tall)– Fully double wide-spreading flowers completely filled with petals. **10/\$11.00**

**7272 - Spanish Bluebells (hyacinthoides hispanica)**– (LS, 8-12" tall)– Also called Wood Hyacinth. Lovely mix of pastel blue, pink, and white bell flowers on sturdy stems. Excellent cut flowers. **20/\$10.50**

**7312 - Grape Hyacinths (Muscari armeniacum)**– (MS, 6-8" tall)– Spikes of bright cobalt blue with subtle white rims, good for forcing, cutting, naturalizing, and borders. Fragrant. **20/\$4.25**

**7422 - Scilla (Siberian Squill)**– (ES, 6-8" tall)– Loose clusters of blue pendant bells with a very long bloom time. Prefers shady, cool locations but will also perform well in full sun. Amazingly hardy and very prolific. **20/\$5.50**

## LILLIES

**5222 - 'Black Jack' Asiatic Lilly**– (SU, 36-48" tall)– Vermillion-ruby red with black spots. Unforgettable. **3/\$9.75**

**5252 - 'Stargazer' Oriental Lilly**– (SU, 36-48" tall)– Fragrant, deep pink flowers with white edges and darker spots. Beautiful. One of my all time favorites. **3/\$10.00**

## TULIPS

**9102 - 'Monsella'**– (ES, 10-12" tall)– A golden yellow double tulip flamed with red. Captures the eye. **10/\$7.25**

**9122 - 'Orange Emperor'**– (ES, 12-16" tall)– Deep salmon-orange with a yellow base. Gorgeous. **10/\$6.50**

**(TULIPS continued)**

**9182 - 'Jan Reus'**– (MS, 18-20" tall)– Dusky reddish-burgundy velvet with dark veins. Great for forcing. **10/\$7.00**

**9202 - 'Princess Irene'**– (MS, 12-14" tall)– Stunningly rich salmon-orange petals are finely etched with a plum-violet flame. Fragrant. Popular for forcing. **10/\$7.00**

**9272 - 'Golden Oxford'**– (MS, 20-24" tall)– Darwin hybrid. Big bold golden-yellow flowers, occasionally touched with red at the rim. **10/\$4.75**

**9322 - 'Pink Impression'**– (MS, 24-28" tall)– Darwin hybrid. Deep rose exterior with deeper veins and pink flames and delicate pink edges. Inside light pink and pale rose. **10/\$6.50**

**9382 - 'Mrs. John T Scheepers'** – (LS, 28-34" tall)– Rich luminous yellow with perfect form. Rated one of the best yellow tulips ever produced. **10/\$7.00**

**9432 - Green Flamed Mix**– (LS, 18-24" tall)– Beautiful mix of colors with a broad green flame up the petals. Long lasting flowers make excellent cut flower bouquets. **10/\$7.75**

**9512 - 'Angelique'**– (LS, 12-18" tall)– Magnificent double tulip with shades of pale pink with lighter edges. Fragrant. Great for forcing. A beauty. **10/\$7.75**

**9021 - Sunset Cutflower Tulip Collection**– A selection of late tulips– reds, yellows, and flames in different varieties and shapes. Total of 65 tulips. A great value! **1 package/\$42.00**
